


ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

- · Congratulations on the purchase of your Nordic Auto Plow a truly unique solution (patent pending) to driveway snow removal.
- Properly assembled and used, the Nordic Auto Plow makes time consuming, back breaking manual snow removal a thing of the past!
- The Nordic Auto Plow was specifically designed and engineered for removal of snow in YOUR driveway. It is NOT to be used commercially, or for any type of street snow removal.
- See warranty and legal disclaimer (attached).
- Please read through the entire assembly sequence before beginning, it will help facilitate assembly. Estimated time for assembly: 30 minutes.
- · Follow the assembly instructions carefully so your finished Nordic Auto Plow will be up to the snowiest task.








IMPORTANT NOTE: FOR VEHICLES WITH BUMPER HEIGHT GREATER

FOR VEHICLES WITH BUMPER HEIGHT GREATER THAN 14", SEE TRUCK MOUNTING METHOD STEP - 14.


RECOMMENDATION: The top of the stud cap should be even with the car's hood. If the supplied stud is too short, please cut your own 2x4 to the proper length. If your car is shorter than the stud supplied, slide the stud through the cog until even with top of the hood.

Slide Studs down into Cogs - flush with bottom of Cog. Slide Stud Caps over tops of Studs so the word "PLOW" is positioned as shown. Secure these parts with (7) 3/4" long flat head screws to each stud as shown.



Attach the (2) Cog Extenders to one of the Cog Plates. Use (4) 1" long bolts, washers and nuts as shown. Make sure Cog Plate rests inside Cog Extender lip. Line up mounting holes and tighten bolts and nuts fully.


Cogs may be moved upward, downward, and side - to - side for attachment on Cog Plates to accommodate your specific vehicle.

NOTE:

For "straighter" (side to side) front bumpers e.g. Jeep, Ford Escape, etc. Bolt the **Cogs** dead center on the **Cog Plates**.

For more curved (side to side) front bumpers, mount the **Cogs** on the insides (toward the center of the car) of both **Cog Plates**.





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The numbers: 9 - 14 on the **Cog Plates** correspond with the distance from the ground to the bottom edge of your bumper.

EXAMPLE:


Measure the distance from the ground to the bottom of the bumper. Let's say it is 10".

Then, place the bottom hole of the Cog over slot #10 on the Cog Plate. (In this case, the opposite bottom hole of the Cog will fall over slot with inverted #14.)

IMPORTANT NOTE:

FOR VEHICLES WITH BUMPER HEIGHT GREATER THAN 14", SEE TRUCK MOUNTING METHOD STEP - 14.

PREVIEW FOR ATTACHING COGS TO COG PLATES IN STEP - 10

Install the 1" Elevator Bolts from underneath the Cog Plates.

The shoulders on the bolts will lock into the slots of the Cog Plates as shown.

Cogs are then secured to the Cog Plates with washers and nuts tightened fully.



CAP, STUD AND COG ASSEMBLY WITHOUT EXTENDER.










CAP, STUD AND COG ASSEMBLY WITH EXTENDER.







Lay the **Blade** face down. Slide the **Cog Assemblies** between ribs on back of the **Blade** in the recommended positions shown. Be sure mounting holes are lined up as shown in the detail.



- Return the Plow Assembly to an upright position so both front and back sides are accessible.
- Feed 1 1/2" long bolts (from the front) through mounting holes in the Blade Sections, Cog Plates, and Cog Plate Extenders as shown.
- Place washers and nuts over bolts and tighten securely. Make sure to install and tighten all (8) 1 - 1/2" long bolts.



TRUCK MOUNTING METHOD - A (WITH INCLUDED HARDWARE)



DEPENDING ON VEHICLE.) STAND 2 X 4'S AGAINST FRONT RUMPER MARK AND CUT 3" BELOW TOP

B - DRILL (2) 3/8" DIAMETER HOLES IN EACH 2 X 4, 11" O.C., 2" IN FROM ONE END. OF HOOD.




THIS SIDE READS: "AUTO" INTO THE HOLES.



IMPORTANT! D - MAKE SURE TEE NUTS, COG, AND STUD CAP (SIDE READING "AUTO") ALL FACE THE SAME DIRECTION




F - SECURE THE 2 X 4'S TO THE BACK OF THE PLOW WITH (4) 3" LONG BOLTS AND NYLON SPACERS (FURNISHED), START BOLTS CAREFULLY INTO THE FRONT OF THE PLOW, SLIDE SPACERS ON, THEN TIGHTEN



POSITION ASSEMBLED BLADE AGAINST THE FRONT BUMPER OF THE TRUCK, CHECK THAT THE STUD WITH CAP IS JUST BELOW THE HOOD. THEN POSITION THE CURVATURE OF THE COGS 1" BELOW THE BUMPER. SECURE COGS TO STUDS WITH 3/4" FLAT HEAD SCREWS SUPPLIED. (3 PER STUD).

ALTERNATE TRUCK MOUNTING METHOD - B (HARDWARE NOT INCLUDED)




THIS METHOD ALLOWS FOR ANGLED PLOWING BY USING THE INCLUDED COGS AND COG EXTENDER PLATE. ("U - BOLT" KITS AND 2 X 4'S MUST BE PURCHASED SEPARATELY)


SECURE THE STUD CAPS WITH (4) 3/4" FLAT HEAD SCREWS EACH, SUP-PLIED, DO NOT SECURE THE COGS YET.

- 1 PERFORM STEPS "14A, D, and E".
- 2 SECURE 2 X 4'S TO COG PLATES WITH (2) 4" X 4" U BOLT KITS AS SHOWN, CAUTION: DO NOT OVER TIGHTEN.
- 3 ATTACH COG PLATES / 2 X 4 ASSEMBLY TO BACK OF PLOW AS IN "STEP - 12" OF INSTRUCTIONS.
- 4 FINALIZE ASSEMBLY BY PERFORMING STEP "14G".

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Keep the Nordic Auto Plow logo facing forward. Wrap the (2) Stud Covers around the studs tightly and secure with the attached Velcro strips. Attach End Markers in the slots provided. Attach the Bungeo Straps as shown above.




Slide the Nordic Auto Plow in front of the vehicle. Cogs will be underneath the bumper. Wrapped Studs should be flush with front of bumper and vertical as shown.

IMPORTANT: HOOD STRAPS MUST BE PROPERLY INSTALLED

- A Adjust Hood Strap lengths as necessary so Hood Clips will easily clip on the back edge of
- B Remove some of the slack from the **Straps**, but don't over tighten. (*Straps will tighten as snow builds during plowing.*)
- **NOTE:** Alternate Placement Locations for the Hood Clips may be the front door openings as shown. (This location may be more suitable for smaller (narrower) vehicles.)
- C PLEASE READ THE CAUTIONARY TAGS ON THE BUNGEE STRAPS FIRST. Attach the Bungeo Straps to the wheel wells or springs on both sides of the vehicle as shown. Adjust each Bungeo Strap so it will not fall off. DO NOT STRETCH EXCESSIVELY.

Instrucions for attachment to the rear of your car (if preferred) are given in the next step.



The **Nordic Auto Plow** may be attached to the rear of your car if preferred. Hood Clips will now be hooked to the leading edge of the trunk. Be sure to attach **Bungee Straps** to rear wheel well or spring as shown above.





When attaching the Straps to an SUV with cross rails and / or luggage racks, follow Steps "A" - "D" above to secure Straps in these instances.



PLEASE NOTE:

If your SUV is not equipped with cross rails, you may secure **Hood Straps** using the **Hood Clips** to the leading edge of the rear hatch as shown above. Be sure to attach **Bungeo Straps** as in **Step - 17**.
