
Remove all contents from the carton.

Assembling the Unit



Starting the Unit




Set the unit on its side. Insert the wheel assembly into the wheel bracket.



Adjust the height by moving the wheel assembly along the wheel


bracket.

NOTE: Moving the wheel assembly down will raise the wheel height. Moving the wheel assembly up will lower the wheel height.



Insert the clevis pin through the wheel bracket and assembly and lock it in place with the cotter pin.

Set the unit upright. Loosen the


knobs. Swing the handlebar up

NOTE: Take care not to pinch

the cables when positioning the

into the operating position.

DO NOT squeeze the throttle control until step 14.



Tighten the knobs securely.



Mix thoroughly in a separate fuel can: - 3.2 fl. oz. of 2-cycle engine oil

- 1 gallon of fresh unleaded gasoline (less than 30 days old) NOTE: Do not mix directly in the unit fuel tank.




Position the unit with the fuel cap facing up. Slowly remove the fuel cap. Fill the fuel tank. Reinstall the fuel cap. Move the unit at least 30 ft. (9.1 m) from the fuel container and the fueling site before starting the engine.




10 X Primer Bulb (10)

Slowly press and release the primer bulb 10 times.




Flip the choke lever clockwise until it clicks

'11



Stand in the starting position. Hold the handlebar firmly with one hand. Hold the starter rope with the other hand. Use one foot to hold the wheels in place. Tilt the unit back slightly to bring the tines off the ground.



Pull the starter rope with a controlled and steady motion until the unit starts.

Idle the engine for 30 seconds.



DIDN'T START?

Repeat the starting instructions.

If the unit still fails to start, refer to the operator's manual for additional starting and troubleshooting information.

Squeeze the throttle control as needed for operation.
